
TURKEY ACHIEVED HIGH RATIO of ODA/GNI, SURPASSING THE TARGET OF

TURKEY'S OFFICIAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE OVER THE YEARS










We Are the Most Generous Country in **Terms of Humanitarian Assistance**




Humanitarian Assistance



Why is TİKA Different?







We carry out sustainable projects in all areas, covering the life of a person

As TİKA, we implement projects in a very broad area from education, health and agriculture to economic development, promotion of cultural heritage projects and training programs.

By reflecting the knowledge and experience of all public institutions and agencies, universities, local administrations and nongovernmental organizations to the world, we lay the foundations of a new humanitarian diplomacy.

Briefly, we are engaged in activities concerning human life from birth to death. The number of hospitals and health centers constructed, renovated and equipped in the last 6 years is more than 300. The number of health care personnel provided with training is above 1,200.

Approximately 850 million people in the world do not have access to clean drinking water. We drilled more than 1,000 water wells between 2003 and 2016. More than 3,500 specialists from various occupational groups, including security, judicial, care, education and diplomacy, were provided with training in the capacity building programs of TIKA between 2003 and 2016.

Additionally, many expert trainers from various public institutions and universities of Turkey were assigned for the on-site training programs. We deliver vocational courses for the disadvantaged people of the society, including women, the handicapped and low-income people, with a sustainable and versatile point of view towards development.




We fulfill our commitment to the least developed countries

Our President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan promised to provide the least developed countries with an annual support of **\$200 million** in the Least Developed Countries Summit of the UN in 2011 in İstanbul.

The total assistance provided by Turkey between 2008-2016 to the Least Developed Countries (LDCs) whose population constitute nearly 15 percent of the world population rose to \$2,057 billion.

We Support Agricultural **Development**

Specialized training courses and implementation projects are developed with a view to ensure that countries become self-sufficient in agricultural production and modern agricultural techniques are applied by skilled labor. In the last 9 years, thousands of experts benefited from the training programs implemented in the agricultural, forestry and fishing sectors with the cooperation of the TİKA and the Ministry of Food, Agriculture and Livestock.

A greenhouse was set up for the first time in Somalia within the agricultural school established in Mogadishu in cooperation with the Humanitarian Relief Foundation (IHH) in 2013. Crops such as melon and aubergine were cultivated for the first time, and training on the use of drip irrigation systems and technical apiculture was delivered for the first time. With the school transformed into a Faculty of Agriculture within Zamzam University as of 2015, contributions are made to ensure propagation of modern agricultural techniques in Somalia.

We Lead the Way for Education with New Projects

We are proud to have carried out **4,250 educational projects so far including the vocational trainings.**

We build schools in an extensive geography spanning from Afghanistan to Macedonia, from Albania to Cambodia, from Ethiopia to Palestine and from Iraq to Colombia. In the regions where we are active, we renovated hundreds of schools from preschools to universities, in order to allow the students to have opportunities for a quality and modern education in their own countries. We provided repair and equipment support for many educational institutions from preschools, to middle schools, high schools and up to universities.



In Orejon, one of the most severely affected regions by the civil war in Colombia, the school we had built as a symbol of peace was inaugurated by Nobel Laureate Colombian former President Juan Manuel Santos.







We set up modern facilities for employment creation

Located in the southern part of the Gaza Strip, within the city of Khan Yunis, people of Abasan al-Kabira Municipality, which has a population of 30,000, make their living through olive cultivation. The town has around 10,000 olive trees on 5,600 decares of land and produces **4,200 tons of olive each year.**

The role of Turkey in the international development cooperation has changed drastically in the recent years. Not only Turkey has transformed from an assistance receiving country into a donor, it has also become a difference-making country, which puts forward unique methods and discourses in its approach to international development cooperation. As one of the leading actors of this change, TİKA builds effective relations with many of the world's leading development cooperation organizations and carries out joint projects.

We Support NGOs as Our **Solution Partners**

Over 500 projects and activities were carried out in more than 70 countries with the cooperation of TİKA and NGOs between 2012-2017. The number of cooperating stakeholders increases each year, and activities are carried out with 80 domestic NGOs on average annually. Only in the sub-Saharan countries, more than 300 thousand people were subjected to medical checkup within the scope of the health care projects carried out in cooperation with NGOs.





We support Women's Empowerment and Equality

660 million people are homeless due to war, violence and natural disasters. The negative events across the world affect mostly the women and the children. TİKA assists women and children, who struggle with access to even basic needs.





We Stand by Victims of Terror

International terrorism, one of the major problems of the world today, jeopardizes at peace and stability of countries. The acts of terrorism and violence result in the death of thousands of people and bring together devastating human crises. TIKA carries out projects in many countries, including Sri Lanka, Somalia, Niger and Iraq, in an attempt to provide relief to the victims of terror at a global level.



We Share Turkey's Experience with Vocational Training Projects




We Improve Administrative and Civil Infrastructures to Increase the Quality of Public Services
